Our Funding

The Institute is **independent** of all party political interests. **It receives no core funding** from government and is not affiliated to any single university. The Institute is a registered charity (Charity number 306083) and maintains itself from research grants, Institute membership fees and income generated from subscription to its academic review and economic policy evaluation tools.
